Session Information

Jan. 20, 2016 – Orientation to the RLND Dickinson Community Short Course, session one

Participants learn about fellow short course participants and the history of the short course. Participants understand what mismanaged agreement means and why we don't speak up in groups. Participants identify needs in the Dickinson area.

Feb. 3, 2016 – Leadership Perspectives, session two

Participants learn about leading from multiple levels. Participants learn how to be an effective leader by becoming more self aware of their own strengths.

Feb. 17, 2016 – Understanding and Managing Conflict, session three

Participants discuss why conflict happens and learn strategies for managing conflict.

Mar. 2, 2016 – Servant Leadership in Your Community, session four

Participants learn why people serve, where people can serve in the Dickinson area, and how they make time to serve (time management).

Mar. 9, 2016 – Civic Engagement: The Power of Individuals Working Together, session five

Participants learn about the change process. Participants discuss civic engagement and how critical it is for a healthy community.
